

Community Resources Center

Lucas County residents interested in utilizing the Pathway Community Resources Center are encouraged to contact Pathway Case Managers at 419 242 7304.

The following documents are required for intake:

- Current documentation of all household income (all members age 18 or older) for the last 3 months.
- A valid photo ID for all adults 18 years of age or older.
- Social Security cards and birth certificates for all household members. -OR-
- One of the following for all household members: voter's registration, valid passport, permanent resident/work visa documentation.
- Letter of support for ALL zero income household members. Letter to be written by person who supports you, and include the names of all supported persons.

Pathway reduces poverty by providing comprehensive services that create pathways to self-sufficiency.

This program offers case management services, including the development of individual goal planning designed to help low-income Lucas County individuals and families become self-sufficient.

Other emergency services are offered on a case-by-case basis, based on household need. Pathway staff also makes referrals to other community and government agencies that provide services Pathway doesn't offer.
