# Winter Crisis Program 2022-2023

The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) Winter Crisis Program starts November 1, 2022 and runs until March 31, 2023. The WCP provides a benefit once per heating season to income-eligible household's main heating and/or electric accounts.

Income eligible Lucas County households must have a gross income at or below 175% poverty guidelines to qualify for assistance and must meet at least one additional eligibility criteria listed below:

- Households that are disconnected or have a pending disconnection notice.
- Households that have 25% (or less) of bulk fuel supply remaining.
- Need to establish new service
- Need to pay to transfer service.
- Households with a PIPP default, or first PIPP.

The maximum benefit amounts for the 2022-2023 program year are:

Up to \$175 for customers of regulated utilities, up to \$750 for customers of un-regulated utilities (municipal utilities or cooperatives), up to \$900 Bulk Fuel benefit, and up to \$500 in Heating Unit Repairs.
